Vaccinations at the DICV site will commence once doses are available; vaccines will be administered by private hospital and government health personnel depending on availability.

In addition to employees, DICV also plans to give the vaccine free to truck drivers of all brands. The company will continue offering the facility as a vaccination centre for as long as necessary.
